Recommendation: Amend Section 3.20.100 of the District Ordinance Code to read: "Subletting by berth renters is not permitted. <u>Berth renters are prohibited from renting</u> their vessel overnight for any length of time, including short-term or long-term vacation rentals."

Recommendation: Authorize the General Manager to enter into a First Agreement Amendment, in accordance with the proposal from the San Mateo Resource Conservation District, for an additional amount not-to-exceed \$110,000 through FY 2019.
