C). 1. Public Comments/Questions

- James Han comments directed to Commissioner Mattusch related to Board dynamics; asked for his resignation. Comments directed to President Chang Kiraly promoting culture of silence. Praised Commissioner Brennan. Urges Sexual Harassment Complaint report be made public.
- John Ullom commented that the Sexual Harassment Complaint report should have been agenized and should be made public. Comments directed to Commissioners Chang Kiraly, Bernardo and Mattusch.

2. Commissioner Comments

- **Commissioner Brennan** read the statement she made at the joint Assembly and Senate Committee on Sexual Harassment Prevention and Response.
- **Commissioner Larenas** stated that the report on the Sexual Harassment Complaint made by Commissioner Brennan should be made public. Stated that he attended the Northern California Beach Water Quality Monitoring Workgroup meeting. Shared findings that were discussed at the workgroup. Also attended the City of Pacifica Sea Level Rise Workshop and went to Sacramento and met with ocean and coastal environmental advocates.
- **Commissioner Mattusch** stated that in 2014 he and Commissioner Brennan were friends before he was elected to office, and that he regrets sending a distasteful email to 41 people, and the unnecessary publicity that it has brought to the Harbor District. He apologized if it offended anyone.

- **Commissioner Bernardo** commented regarding PowerPoint presentations, that when creating or giving a presentation, people should not just read the bullet points, but should add in points of discussion that are not in the presentation beyond the bulleted points.
- **President Chang Kiraly** stated that in the past, she received a pornographic email from a person sitting in the audience, copied to others, which one person considered cyber-bullying. Commissioner Chang Kiraly stated that she understands that the public can say whatever they would like and knows that it is part of her job as a Commissioner.
